



The finesse, delicacy and expressiveness of this wine are remarkable. It has bright ruby color with aromas of black cherries and a faint hint of earthiness. It's soft and round through the midpalate carrying flavors of cherries, black currants and chocolate balanced with refreshing acidity. The long, tasty finish highlights the rich tannins that give it such powerful structure.

**Origin of Grape:** The fruit for this wine comes from Champoux Vineyards, located 3 miles above the Columbia River in the Horse Heaven Hills AVA. Champoux is one of Washington State's premiere vineyards with some of the oldest and most sought after Cabernet Sauvignon grapes first planted in 1972.

**Compostion:** 67% Cabernet Sauvignon, 17% Cabernet Franc, 12% Merlot, 4% Petit Verdot
